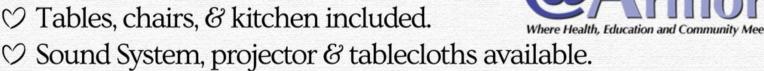

# Membership Spotlight Dottie Steelman

For anyone who has had the pleasure of knowing Dottie Steelman in any capacity, you already know that she exudes all the best gualities human nature has to offer. She loves hard, she works hard, she gives a lot of her time and self to others and the love of Jesus shines through her in all that she does. Dottie is a wife to her husband, Joel, and a mother to seven children ranging from her 18-year-old to her toddler twins. Motherhood is demanding no matter your family size, but Dottie never holds back from volunteering and supporting any activity or organization her children are involved in. She doesn't just volunteer on paper either. She jumps in with both feet and does the WORK. This was abundantly clear with her latest endeavor as she single-handedly took it upon herself to start a youth volleyball league in Dent County. Dottie was a standout volleyball player for Salem High School and part of our state championship volleyball team in 1997. From there she went on to play a year for Three Rivers Community College in Poplar Bluff. In her adult years, she has kept up with the sport she loves through refereeing and a year of coaching in Bunker. Fast forward to her oldest daughter seeking a traveling team to play with. Dottie found herself and other parents driving their children to Eminence during the week for practices and games. She realized the need for this league to form in Salem. She knew that other towns had a huge advantage in the sport as the kids had been playing in an organized format from the time, they started school. Salem was having a hard time being competitive in the sport since many of our kids didn't get to play together until middle school or Freshman year. Dottie didn't complain about this. She got busy changing it! She requested a meeting with Healthy Dent County, made some phone calls to other towns and the ball was in motion. Salem started their first youth volleyball league in April of 2023 and after a month of practices, games were held in May. Salem had 11 teams, Bunker and Steelville brought 3 teams each and Viburnum brought 5 teams. Over 200 girls, ranging from pk to 6th grade, had a volleyball team to play on! Dottie organized the volunteer coaches, referees, scorekeepers, workers for concessions, and admissions table, she supplied the concessions, and she got the shirts made. Each week, she created a practice and game schedule and made all contact with teams, coaches, and parents. To say she was busy would be a complete understatement. During the month of May, the Healthy Dent County Gymnasium was packed with players and spectators alike on Monday and Thursday evenings. This was a free league for players. Costs were covered through money made in concessions and admissions. Not only did our youth benefit from this, but our entire community did as well. With 11 teams coming from other towns, our local businesses also benefited from this youth league. At the conclusion of the first league, Dottie donated all the profit after expenses to Healthy Dent County to be used for new volleyball equipment for our entire community to use! She did not want to keep any of it for herself.

On top of being a wife, mother and active volunteer for the community, Dottie also works very hard to be active and get workouts in. She enjoys coming to Interval Training, Tighten & Tone, xPRESS, and Kickboxing classes. She always makes the classes more fun with her stories and banter and great attitude. When Dottie can't make a class, she tries very hard to fit home workouts into her busy schedule. If a busy woman like Dottie can carve out time for herself and her health, it's safe to assume most everyone can if they really try. It's not easy for her. She struggles to find time, but she never gives up. She never stops trying to better herself in every way. She has no idea what a true inspiration she is to many!
