KEYNOTE SPEAKER Rebekah Hagan

Raised in a Christian home where abortion was never discussed, Rebekah Hagan became pregnant at seventeen and again with a second child in her first year of college.

Feeling ashamed, fearing her family's disappointment, and wondering if she would be forced to drop out of school, Rebekah thought that raising two children alone would be impossible. At just over seven weeks pregnant, she began a medication abortion that would end her child's life.

Moreover, they both make time to include fitness in their lives.

Many would wonder why someone this busy would choose to add more to an already busy schedule. Justin says it serves as a great stress reducer and he enjoys the physical challenges associated with it. Fitness helps him build a healthy mind and body. The discipline required carries over to his day-to-day tasks.

Fitness started in his life over 20 years ago when he was still in school. It began to boost his athletic performance in school sports.
